Who is Family Health Council?

Family Health Council of Central PA (FHCCP) is a non-profit organization dedicated to improving health, preventing disease, and promoting wellness.

What does the Healthy Hive do?

The Youth Advisory Board, ***The Healthy Hive***, advises FHCCP's adolescent health programming. This includes things like:

- Reviewing prevention curriculum and providing feedback
- Participating in FHCCP's annual adolescent health needs assessment
- Discussing FHCCP's programming and how to make improvements
- Supporting public health messaging campaigns
- Being invited to participate in FHCCP's community coalition meetings

Prevention curriculum and public health messaging aims to raise awareness and support for reproductive health education. Reproductive health education is about building knowledge and skills. Topics covered in health education often include:

- anatomy
- adolescent development
- healthy relationships
- communication skills
- preventing pregnancy
- preventing sexually transmitted infections

- Spend about 1-2 hours reviewing materials including curriculum and public health campaign messages, as needed
